S.A. Resolution #25 Calling for an Investigation of the Quarter System

Sponsored by: Blake Brown '17 and William Bitsky '16

- **Whereas**, the Quarter System was formally enacted in 2011 with the intent to decrease high-risk drinking among first-year students,
- **Whereas**, there remains uncertainty about the unintended consequences of the Quarter System, including social activity and alcohol consumption in unregulated, off-campus environments,
- **Whereas**, a mission of the Student Assembly is to promote the safety of the student body and student communities and to enhance the overall student experience,
- Whereas, Article III Section 2 of the Student Assembly Charter states that one of the six principal actions of the Assembly is investigation: "action of the SA to gain information on issues pertinent to its purview,"
- **Be it therefore resolved**, that the Student Assembly calls for the creation of an ad-hoc investigation committee for the purpose of exploring the impact and use of the Quarter System,
- **Be it further resolved**, that the body produces a comprehensive report of its findings to be reviewed by the Student Assembly by May 01, 2015 and cease operations thereafter.
- **Be it finally resolved,** that the committee will include at least one SA representative, maintain even representation among Greek and non-Greek students, and be cochaired by a member of the Student Assembly and a member of the Greek Tri-Council
