Dear Jordan,

Thank you for sending me Student Assembly Resolution 5: Updating the Charter.

I am requesting that the Student Assembly reconsider Article III, Section 2, Part A: Reporting to the President. Suggestions for wording revisions are included below and the reasons for these revisions are as follows:

I would like to clarify that the University President is responsible for responding only to those resolutions that have been communicated to him/her, not all resolutions.

Also, there are times when I have relied on individuals to provide additional information to the Student Assembly who are not included in the areas which you have listed (Cabinet, Senior Administration, etc.). I would appreciate a more broad statement being made in the Charter to reflect this.

An additional response from other University partners may come after my review, thus potentially falling outside the 30 day timeframe. As long as this is an <u>additional</u> response, I believe removing this time constraint is warranted.

Please note that in Article III Section 1, as well as Appendix A Section 4, there are references to the Vice President for <u>Student and Academic Services</u>, which now is the Vice President for <u>Student and Campus Life</u>.

I approve all other changes made to the Charter.

Article III, Section 2, Part A: Reporting to the President

All actions, excluding internal policy changes that do not affect the Student Assembly Charter, of the SA will be reported by the SA President to the University President. The SA will respond to any requests for information from the University President on its actions. The University President may also request reconsideration of legislation proposed by the SA. Such a request must be filed within thirty days of notification of the legislation. The SA will take action on such a request, and, if the legislation is upheld, the SA will inform the University President. If the legislation is upheld and if the University President still deems the action to be defective, the University President may veto the action of the SA. The University President will review all actions of the SA that have been reported to him or her and provide a written response to all those actions of the SA within 30 days. The University President, when appropriate, may also designate a another member of the University administration his or her Cabinet, Senior Administration, Provost's Office or Dean of Student's Office to provide an additional written response to an action of the SA within 30 days when appropriate.

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
