13 **Whereas:** The Cornell Committee on Expressive Activity [CCEA] was charged by former  
14 University President Martha Pollack with recommending changes to the University’s existing  
15 policies governing expressive activity in 2023.

16 **Whereas:** On October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024, the CCEA reported to the Cornell community with a draft  
17 policy requesting feedback by December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024 in order to finalize its recommendations in  
18 line with the University’s policy review process.

19 **Whereas:** The GPSA Student Advocacy Committee has held three meetings on the topic of the  
20 Expressive Activity Policy draft since the Policy’s release to formalize the GPSA’s response to  
21 the draft policy on behalf of the graduate student community.

22 **Whereas:** members from the Cornell Graduate Student Union (CGSU) have been included and  
23 involved in contributing to the GPSA’s formalized response to the expressive activity policy  
24 draft.

25 **Be it therefore resolved:** The Statement on the Draft Expressive Activity Policy be adopted by  
26 the Graduate and Professional Student Assembly.

27 **Be it therefore resolved:** The GPSA recommends an expansion of graduate and undergraduate  
28 student representation on the CCEA beyond 5 of 19 committee seats.

29 **Be it finally resolved:** The Graduate and Professional Student assembly disapproves the  
30 Expressive Activity Policy October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024 draft.
