Whereas, students will lose subscription access to the Wall Street Journal unless the Student Assembly transfers funds from the Student Assembly's reserves,

Be it therefore resolved, the Student Assembly shall transfer \$3,000 from the Student Assembly reserves to the Collegiate Readership Program,
