12 York Times and the Wall Street Journal,

13 **Whereas**, the Collegiate Readership Program is a by-line fund, managed by the Student
14 Assembly and Cornell Library Services,

15 **Whereas**, the Wall Street Journal's total subscription price is approximately \$3,000 more than
16 was previously allocated for in the current Student Activity Fee,

17 **Whereas**, students will lose subscription access to the Wall Street Journal unless the Student
18 Assembly transfers funds from the Student Assembly's reserves,

19 **Be it therefore resolved**, the Student Assembly shall transfer \$3,000 from the Student Assembly
20 reserves to the Collegiate Readership Program,
