Q: HOW WILL YOU ENSURE YOUR EDUCATION COMPONENT OUTWEIGHS THE SOCIAL?

Q: WITH THE AMENDMENTS MADE TO THE ORIGINAL SUBMISSION, DOES THIS QUALIFY AS THE SAME EVENT?

A: While we have made amendments to our original submission, the *overall event infrastructure is the same*. We have adjusted our event's cost structure to *direct expenses towards only Cornell students and for our total ask to adhere more to Special Projects funding capabilities*, per the committee members' request at the previous hearing on Feb 6.

Q: HOW WILL WE PROCEED IF ASM IS UNABLE TO FUND ALL EXPENSES?

A: We understand the Student Assemblies committee has complete discretion on our Special Projects budget request, which is why *we are prepared to self-fund overages with our own budget and can also access capital from our founder if needed*.
