Resolution 38: Approving Budget for Finals Week Airport Shuttle

Abstract: This resolution approves \$4,580 for finals week airport shuttle.

Current Status: Placed on the Second Reading Calendar, 03/06/2025

Whereas, students have historically had low access to transit to the Syracuse and Ithaca airports.

Whereas, the transit that is available, such as Uber, is often expensive or not available at times
10 when students need to get to the airport.

Whereas, the previous shuttle initiatives have demonstrated high interest from the student
12 population and received positive feedback.

Be it therefore resolved, \$4,580 be transferred from the Student Assembly Reserve Account to
14 the Office of the Dean of Students.

Be it further resolved, the tickets for these buses shall be at no charge to undergraduate
16 students.

Be it further resolved, these funds will be used to charter buses multiple times after the finish of
18 finals to both the Ithaca and Syracuse airports.

Be it further resolved, students shall sign up for transport via Campus Groups on a first-come,
20 first-serve basis.

Be it finally resolved, these funds shall be severable, and any funds that are unused in this
22 initiative shall be reappropriated to the Student Assembly Reserve Account after the end of the
23 Spring 2025 academic term.
