Resolution 17: Reinstating the A&S Peer Mentoring Program

- 3 Abstract: The College of Arts and Sciences Peer Mentoring Program has recently been paused in
- 4 order to improve and revamp the program. This program was vital for easing the transition
- 5 between high school and college and ensuring that first-year students feel supported by their
- 6 peers. This resolution seeks to reinstate the program as part of the A&S Ambassadors mission.

- Whereas, the College of Arts and Sciences is the largest college at Cornell University, with over
- 4,600 undergraduate students currently enrolled, and overall enrollment has been increasing in
- 14 recent years;
- 15 Whereas, the College of Arts and Sciences Advising Department is dedicated to supporting "the
- academic, personal, and professional growth of all undergraduate students in the College of Arts
- 17 & Sciences";
- 18 Whereas, the College of Arts & Sciences previously maintained a Peer Mentoring Program to
- 19 support first-year students' academic and social transition, similar to programs maintained by
- 20 peer Cornell colleges and schools (such as ILR and the College of Engineering);
- Whereas, the A&S Peer Mentoring Program, which offered valuable peer-to-peer connections
- 22 for first year students, has recently been put on pause;
- Whereas, the absence of structured peer mentorship has reduced first-year students' access to
- 24 near-peer guidance and informal academic navigation, causing undue stress as the transition to
- college is often confusing and overwhelming for many students;
- Whereas, student peer advisors offer valuable information, tips, and support from a uniquely
- 27 student perspective;
- 28 **Be it therefore resolved,** the Student Assembly recommends that the College of Arts and
- 29 Sciences complete their restructuring of and be prepared to implement the A&S Peer Mentoring
- 30 Program by academic year 2026-2027;

- 31 **Be it further resolved,** the Student Assembly recommends that the College of Arts and Sciences
- ensure the new Peer Mentoring Program provides support to First-Year students, throughout the
- *entire* academic year by requiring that Peer Advisors send at least *two* email outreach messages
- 34 be sent to their advisees per semester and host 2-in person events per semester for their mentees
- 35 to discuss subjects related to first year student success;
- 36 **Be it further resolved,** the Student Assembly recommend that the College of Arts and Sciences
- match first-year students with mentors that share their academic interests;
- 38 **Be it further resolved,** the Student Assembly recommends that the College of Arts and Sciences
- pair peer mentors with a specific section of the AS advising seminar (AS 1102) and require
- 40 mentors to attend at least one of their meeting times to provide students with valuable
- 41 perspectives on life at Cornell;
- 42 **Be it further resolved,** the Student Assembly recommends that the College of Arts and Sciences
- 43 Advising Team reinstate the Peer Mentoring Program as an entity separate from the A&S
- 44 Ambassadors so as to reduce the time and work burden required of the Ambassadors;
- 45 **Be it finally resolved,** the Student Assembly Recommends that the College of Arts and Sciences
- Advising Team to solicit the opinions, experiences, and views of current A&S students (via
- 47 survey, email etc.) regarding what can be improved and what can be maintained in the A&S Peer
- 48 Advising Program.
