Resolution 31: Incorporating the Cornell Meal Plan at Trillium Dining Hall

- 3 Abstract: Given the lack of accessible dining hall options on Central Campus and the strong
- 4 student interest in expanding meal swipe usability, this resolution proposes reintroducing the
- 5 Cornell meal plan Meals-To-Go system and introducing a meal plan breakfast program at
- 6 Trillium Dining Hall.

- 11 Current Status: Adopted by the Assembly, Unanimous Consent, 02/27/2025
- Whereas, the majority of classes for undergraduates occur on Central campus during traditional
- breakfast and lunch hours (8AM 3PM);
- Whereas, Oakenshields is currently the only Central Campus eatery that accepts meal swipes,
- leading to lunchtime overcrowding and inconvenience for students, particularly those on the
- 16 Agriculture Quad (College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, College Human Ecology, Brooks
- 17 School of Public Policy);
- 18 Whereas, Oakenshields does not serve breakfast, and so there is no meal plan breakfast option
- on Central Campus;
- Whereas, over 1,200 Cornell undergraduate students are varsity student-athletes, whose
- 21 schedules involve a substantial amount of time on East Campus far from meal swipe dining
- 22 halls;
- Whereas, the Cornell Student and Campus Life website describes Trillium as "in the heart of
- 24 Central Campus," and "one of our most popular food courts;"
- 25 Whereas, Trillium Dining Hall currently offers two breakfast meal options on a daily, pay-per-
- item basis to a relatively low density of students, many of whom are varsity student-athletes;
- Whereas, Trillium Dining Hall, located on the east side of Central Campus, exclusively operates
- 28 on a pay-per-item basis, making it inaccessible to students reliant on meal swipes for their
- 29 breakfast and lunch dining needs;

- Whereas, during the start of the academic year, due to the worker strike, a temporary Meals-To-
- 31 Go program was implemented, demonstrating that Trillium has the capacity to serve pre-boxed
- meal swipe options efficiently;
- Whereas, many peer institutions offer a combination of pay-per-item and meal swipe options in
- 34 centralized campus locations to increase student accessibility and convenience;
- 35 **Be it therefore resolved,** the Student Assembly urges Cornell Dining to introduce a permanent
- 36 'meal swipe option' at Trillium Dining Hall, offering pre-boxed meal options for swipe usage via
- 37 expanding the Meals-To-Go program to include a pick-up option at Trillium;
- 38 **Be it further resolved,** the Student Assembly urges Cornell Dining to allow Trillium Dining
- 39 Hall breakfast to become a meal swipe option;
- 40 **Be it further resolved,** the Student Assembly urges Cornell Dining to allow Trillium Dining
- 41 Hall breakfast to become a meal swipe option from 8AM 10:30AM daily;
- 42 **Be it further resolved,** the Meals-to-Go program should be available at least during peak lunch
- 43 hours (11 AM 2 PM) to alleviate overcrowding at other meal swipe locations;
- 44 **Be it finally resolved,** the Office of the Student Assembly President and the Student Assembly
- 45 Dining Committee shall work directly with Cornell Dining and the University Administration to
- develop an implementation plan ensuring feasibility, affordability, and accessibility.
