- explains the purpose of Special Projects Funding as follows:
- Section 1: The Student Assembly may choose to fund any project, program or service through the Assembly Special Projects that it deems to improve the quality of undergraduate student life. Special Projects funding is a type of category spending.
- Whereas, Part B: Special Projects Funding, Section 2, Subsection A of the Student Assembly
- 21 Standing Rules, describes the requirement to be considered for Special Projects Funding as
- 22 follows:
- 23 (a) Any Cornell registered student organization
- Whereas, Part B: Special Projects Funding, Section 5 of the Student Assembly Standing Rules outlines the rules of Special Projects Funding based on the amount as follows:
- Section 5: Requests \$2,500 and over shall be decided upon by a majority vote of the Executive Board and confirmed by a majority vote of the Student Assembly, at large.
