Resolution 8: Calling for Divestment from War Weapons Manufacturers

- 3 *Abstract:* This resolution expresses the will of the Spring 2024 student referendum and
- 4 recommends divestment from weapons manufacturers to the Board of Trustees, per the 2016
- 5 Divestment Guidelines.
- 6 Sponsored by: Karys Everett '25, Imani Rezaka, '25
- 7 *Type of Action:* Sense-of-the-Body
- 8 Originally Presented: 10/10/2024
- 9 *Current Status:* Postponed Indefinitely, 5-4-6, 10/10/2024
- 10 Whereas in 2016, the Board of Trustees approved a <u>Standard and Process for Review of</u>
- 11 <u>Divestment Requests'</u> in which the university must consider divesting from companies that,
- 12 through their "action or inaction," partake in "morally reprehensible activities" such as
- 13 "apartheid, genocide, human trafficking, slavery, and systemic cruelty to children" and
- 14 perpetuate "harm so grave that it would be inconsistent with the goals and principles of the
- 15 University,"
- 16 Whereas, The 2016 Divestment Guidelines empower the five shared governance bodies,
- including the Student Assembly, "to assist the President and the Board in making decisions
 regarding social responsibility,"
- 19 Whereas April 22nd, 2024, the Cornell undergraduate population voted 2:1 to divest from the
- 20 following weapons manufacturers: BAE Systems, Boeing, Elbit Systems, General Dynamics,
- 21 L3Harris Technologies, Leonardo, Lockheed Martin, Northrop Grumman, RTX, and
- 22 ThyssenKrupp,
- 23 Whereas on Thursday, November 13th 2008, the Student assembly passed <u>Resolution 13:</u>
- 24 <u>Encourage Action in Congo</u>,
- Whereas on Thursday 24th, 2021, the Student Assembly passed <u>Resolution 39: Calling Upon</u>
 <u>Cornell to Uphold its Ethical Guidelines</u>,
- 27 Whereas the Student Assembly passed <u>Resolution 2: Conflict Free Campus Resolution</u>,
- 28 Whereas in direct relation to the tensions on campus today, on Thursday April 10th, 2014 the
- 29 Student Assembly passed <u>Resolution 72: Resolution Urging Cornell University to Divest From</u>
- 30 Companies Profiting from Israeli Occupation and Human Rights Violations,

76	including but not limited to submarines, warships, naval electronics, towers for battle
77	tanks and artillery guns, and machine gun mountings,

79	Whereas the inconsistencies between the harm that the following companies perpetuate and
80	Cornell's stated core values constitute grounds for the consideration of divestment,
81	Whereas Cornell's failure to begin the process for divestment from the aforementioned
82	companies is a breach of the Board of Trustees' Standard and Process for Review of
83	Divestment Requests,

85	Whereas there is precedent for socially responsible divestment from companies complicit in
86	morally reprehensible acts, such as Cornell University's moratorium on fossil fuel investments in
87	May 2022 and the liquidation of Cornell's holdings in Sudan (including government bonds and
88	oil company stocks) in light of the Sudanese government's involvement in genocide in 2006,
