

1 This document provides the line-by-line recommended changes to the Cornell Student Code of
2 Conduct ("Code") as per University Assembly Resolution 6: Recommending Changes to the
3 Student Code of Conduct to Address Excessive Littering.

7 **Section: VI(G). Disorderly Conduct**

8 **Page 7, Paragraph 1**

9 "To intentionally cause or recklessly create a risk of disruption to the University community or
10 local community, including, but not limited to:

- 11 1. Violent or threatening behavior;
- 12 2. Unreasonably loud or belligerent behavior;
- 13 3. Obstruction of vehicular or pedestrian traffic"

14 UA Recommended Revision:

- 15 - Addition: "4. Intentional and excessive littering"

16 **Section: VI(N). Misconduct Related to Student Organizations or Groups**

17 **Page 10, Paragraph 3**

18 "Student groups or organizations (including fraternities and sororities) that engage in prohibited
19 conduct as defined under this Code, including but not limited to hazing, alcohol-related
20 behavior, and failure to comply with University policies and regulations governing their conduct,
21 and/or that breach their formal agreements with the university for registration or recognition,
22 may be held accountable under this Code and associated procedures."

23 UA Recommended Revision:

- 24 - Substitute with: "Student groups or organizations (including fraternities and sororities)
25 that engage in prohibited conduct as defined under this Code, including but not limited
26 to hazing, alcohol-related behavior, [disorderly conduct](#), and failure to comply with
27 University policies and regulations governing their conduct, and/or that breach their
28 formal agreements with the university for registration or recognition, may be held
29 accountable under this Code and associated procedures."

30 **Section: VI(Q). Property Damage**

31 **Page 11, Paragraph 1**

32 "Actions that result in or can be reasonably expected to result in damage to property, including
33 electronic data, files, or other information. This includes property owned by the University, or
34 other entities and individuals without regard to whether they are affiliated with the University."

35 UA Recommended Revision:

- 36 - Substitute with: "Actions that result in or can be reasonably expected to result in
37 damage to property, including electronic data, files, or other information. This includes
38 property owned by the University, or other entities and individuals without regard to
39 whether they are affiliated with the University, [such as public spaces, trails, and both on-](#)

40 campus and off-campus Natural Areas. The repeated excessive throwing or leaving of
41 objects, trash or debris onto these properties will be collectively considered as a singular
42 act of damage to property.”
