Resolution #58 1 **Know the Power of Your Words Campaign** 2 3 ABSTRACT: This resolution requests that the Know the Power of Your 4 5 Words Campaign become an official annual event under the Student Assembly's purview from the Communications Committee. 6 7 8 Sponsored by: Lindsay Wershaw '16, Yamini Bhandari '17, Joseph Fridman '17, 9 Ian Harris '16 10 11 Whereas, the Student Assembly has sought to advance a campus culture of mutual respect 12 and understanding, 13 14 Whereas, the Know the Power of Your Words Campaign has been a successful vehicle for 15 connecting communities and building a more inclusive and supportive campus culture. 16 17 Whereas, instituting the Campaign as an Assembly initiative will offer another opportunity 18 for members of the Cornell community to come together to facilitate intergroup dialogue, 19 20 **Be it therefore resolved,** that the Student Assembly is charged with the oversight of the Know the Power of Your Words campaign under the Communications Committee, 21 22 23 Be it further resolved, that the Student Assembly will allocate a budget of up to \$300 24 annually, under the S.A. communication budget as a new line item to go towards the event 25 for publicity measures, room reservation costs, and food, 26 27 **Be it finally resolved**, that Article VI, Section 3 of the Bylaws is amended to include the 28 following clause: 29 30 D. Communications Committee 31 A. The charge of the KTPOYW Event will be charged to the Communications 32 Committee to: 33 1. Facilitate an annual Know the Power of Your Words Campaign Forum; 34 2. Work with student groups to produce relevant educational 35 programming and discussions all year-round; 3. Work with SACIDI to encourage an inclusive dialogue at the event and 36 37 to ensure all collective voices are heard: 38 39
