Abstract: In order to ensure that additional funding is used to best benefit the Cornell undergraduate population, the Student Assembly provides stipulations on the usage of the \$400,000 transfer to the Slope Day Programming Board.

Whereas, the Student Assembly has an obligation to ensure that SAF funds are allocated in the best interest of the undergraduate population.

Whereas, the Student Assembly intends for the \$400,000 transfer to be used to provide as much additional benefit to the 2024 Slope Day as possible, instead of to a proceeding event.

Be it therefore resolved, Resolution 23 shall be amended to insert the following language, starting on line 29:

Be it further resolved, the Student Assembly mandates that the \$400,000 transfer be earmarked for usage towards the artist selection fee for the 2024 Slope Day.

Be it further resolved, the Student Assembly Vice President for Finance be authorized to enforce the provisions of this resolution.
