5	Whereas, the University Assembly (the "Assembly") has the authority to examine matters which
6	concern the welfare of a substantial segment of the campus community and may make
7 8	recommendations thereon to the President or other appropriate officers of the university, and
9	Whereas, undergraduates are made aware of the bias reporting system and resources on campus
0	while many graduate students and employees are not, and
2	Whereas, these systems are in place to create a better environment and to resolve instances of
3	conflict between members of the community, and

5	Whereas, many graduate students and employees are not adequately informed of these systems
6	and resources upon arrival to the University, and
7	
8	Whereas, by not being informed, they are less prepared to take advantage of and utilize these
9	resources, if needed, to serve their needs, therefore be it

21	Resolved, the President task the Vice President of Human Resources and Safety Services to
22	appoint a committee to investigate how to better educate and maintain awareness of the Bias

26	and Professional Student Assembly, and two employees appointed by the Employee Assembly,
