- Whereas, On Friday, November 4th, 2022 at 8 PM, a Crime Alert went out notifying the Cornell
- 16 community of four events at which students reported having been exposed to Rohypnol,
- commonly known as "roofying" at a fraternity residence;
- Whereas, On November 3rd, 2022 at 10:23AM, an "Officer dispatched to take a report
- 19 regarding students reported to have consumed little to no alcohol at an off-campus location but
- became incapacitated while attending parties. The individuals reported they were exposed to
- 21 Rohypnol (commonly known as "roofies")." at 800 University Avenue;
- 22 Whereas, Less than two days later on Sunday, November 6th, 2022 at 4PM, another Crime Alert
- 23 went out notifying the Cornell community of a sexual assault that also occurred at a fraternity
- 24 residence;
- Whereas, On November 6th, 2022 at 04:42AM, "Cornell University Police assisted the Ithaca
- 26 Police Department with a reported sexual assault complaint." at 140 Thurston Avenue;
- Whereas, On Sunday, November 6th, the Interfraternity Council (IFC) temporarily suspended
- all fraternity parties and social events;



- Whereas, On Monday, November 7th, President Pollack and Vice President Lombardi released
- a joint statement condemning these disturbing events and reminded the community that this
- 31 behavior must be eradicated:
- Whereas, Cornell University is committed to facilitating a culture of safety, consent, and
- 33 inclusivity;
- Whereas, All students must feel safe and supported in Greek life and other social spaces;
- 35 **Be it therefore resolved,** For Cornell University to remain true to its motto of "Any Person, Any
- 36 Study" Cornell must reaffirm its dedication to promoting the safety of students of all genders,
- 37 sexual orientations, races, and other backgrounds;
- 38 **Be it further resolved,** the Cornell Student Assembly unequivocally condemns sexual assault
- and the drugging of our peers in the strongest possible terms;
- 40 **Be it finally resolved,** the Student Assembly urges administration to implement actionable steps
- 41 to reduce the harm inflicted on our community, including but not limited to:
- Strengthening mandatory semesterly trainings on consent culture at which a majority of fraternity members from each chapter are present
 - Exploring a furthered partnership between the Tompkins County Advocacy Center and Greek life organizations to promote healthy relationships and improve the safety of social settings
 - Bolstering support for survivors of sexual assault, including restructuring the Title IX
 Office to reduce wait times with support staff, decrease case resolution times, and
 provide support if survivors pursue legal action
