

Resolution 16: GPSA Reserve Fund Drawdown

- 2 Abstract: At the end of the GPSA year, all unused funds are transferred to a reserve fund. There is
- 3 currently a substantial amount of funds in the reserve account, with no official mechanisms to draw
- 4 down from this account.

- Whereas, the unused GPSA funds are transferred to a reserve fund at the end of the GPSA term.
- 8 Whereas, there is currently a substantial amount of money located in the reserve fund.
- Whereas, there is not a mechanism within the GPSA bylaws that allow for the assembly to use
- these funds.

- Be it resolved, section E will be added to section 3.16 of the GPSA Bylaws stating that "any
- 12 current GPSA voting member, or field representative can propose a resolution to use funds from
- the GPSA reserve account. This resolution must be approved by a majority vote of present voting
- 14 members and field representatives."
- 15 **Be it further resolved,** section i. will be added under section E stating that "a limit of how much
- can be approved by members present and anything above the limit requires a two-thirds majority
- vote of the entire GPSA, both voting and non-voting members. This limit is \$3000.
- Be it finally resolved, resolutions can only be passed when reserves are at least 10% of annual
