Sponsored by: Varun Devatha '19 7 8 Whereas, Cornell University was founded by Ezra Cornell as an "institution where any person can find 9 instruction in any study," 10 11 Whereas, all members of the Cornell community are technically ex-officio members of the Student 12 Assembly, 13 14 Whereas, veterans are an underrepresented population on the Cornell campus with a series of unique 15 experiences, 16 17 Whereas, veterans struggle with inclusivity as well as knowledge of organizations, support centers, and 18 resources across campus, 19 20 Whereas, Cornell University has committed to increasing the veteran student population by planning on 21 quadrupling the veteran population to 100 by fall of 2020, 22 23 Be it therefore resolved, a Veteran's Ex-Officio Representative to the Student Assembly be instated with 24 the following language added after Article I, Section 3, line 22 of the Student Assembly Bylaws: 25 26 C. The SA will grant one member from Cornell University Veteran Association an ex-officio position as an 27 organizational liaison.
