4	ABSTRACT: This resolution calls for increasing access to gender neutral bathrooms across campus.

8	Whereas, transgender and gender non-conforming persons may face discomfort and discrimination
9	when using gendered bathrooms;

11	Whereas, the university has made strides in increasing access to gender neutral bathrooms since SA
12	resolution 21, "Availability of Accessible Gender-Neutral Bathrooms and Locker Rooms on
13	Campus" was adopted during the 2011-12 school year;

15	Whereas, bathrooms in dorms on West Campus operate under the gender inclusive "E" system;

17	Whereas, Cornell Maps shows locations for all-gender bathrooms across campus;
18	Wileson, doing trupe one to enterior for an Serial Samileonic across campus,
19	Whereas, many buildings used heavily by undergraduates contain no gender neutral Bathrooms;
20	whereas, many buildings used neavily by undergraduates contain no gender neutral bathrooms,
21	Whereas, Robert Purcell Community Center, Appel Commons, and the Townhouse Community
22	Center, important community centers for freshman, contain no gender neutral bathrooms;

25	Whereas, students should not require a map to find a bathroom they can use;

26	Whereas, existing gendered bathrooms can be converted into gender neutral bathrooms promptly
27	and cost-effectively;

29	Be it therefore resolved, that Cornell University set the goal for itself that every building on
30	campus will contain at least one gender neutral bathroom;
31	
32	Be it further resolved, that in buildings where there are no gender neutral or single user restrooms,
33	Cornell University will redesignate a gendered multi-stall bathroom to be gender neutral;
34	
35	Be it further resolved, in future renovations Cornell University will incorporate designs for gender
36	neutral restrooms;

38	Be it further resolved, that Willard Straight Hall enters a trial period in which all bathrooms on the
39	fourth floor be designated all-gender;

41	Be it further resolved, that Bartels Hall, Duffield Hall, Statler Hotel, Robert Purcell Community
42	Center, Appel Commons, Helen Newman Hall, Myron Taylor Hall, and Day Hall be considered
43	high priority for inclusion of gender neutral bathrooms;
