1 S.A. Resolution #42
2 Approving Special Projects Request for Slope Day Programming Board

4 ABSTRACT: This resolution approves the \$12,500 of Special Projects funding for Slope Day
5 Programming Board.

9 **Whereas**, According to the Student Assembly Standing Rules, Special Project “[r]equests \$1500 and over
10 shall be decided upon by a majority vote of the Appropriations Committee and confirmed by a majority vote
11 of the Student Assembly, at large. The SA, at large, is only required to confirm requests of \$1500 or greater.
12 The request should be presented to the Student Assembly in the form of a resolution.”

14 **Whereas**, the Appropriations Committee, by a majority vote, decided to grant Slope Day Programming
15 Board \$12,500 to fund the breakfast and alternative slope day; and

16
17 **Whereas**, the Appropriations Committee expects \$10,000 to go towards funding the breakfast and \$2,500 to
18 go towards Alternative Slope Day; and

19
20 **Whereas**, these events are open to the campus community and benefit a substantial number of Cornell
21 students; then

23 **Be it therefore resolved**, the Student Assembly approves of this Special Projects disbursement; and

25 **Be it further resolved**, the Student Assembly strongly recommends that Slope Day Programming Board
26 not continue to apply for special projects funding to fund their operations, given that their by-line
27 funding has been increased by \$1 per student; and

29 **Be it finally resolved**, the Student Assembly encourages all undergraduate students to attend these
30 events.
