- Whereas, the 2023-2024 academic year theme is "Freedom of Expression", and this ad hoc
- 14 committee will bring speakers from outside of the Cornell community to support this theme.
- Whereas the Committee will run within the purview of the Student Assembly, and each speaker
- event and every speaker shall be introduced by the chair of the committee and the President of the
- 17 Student Assembly.
- 18 Whereas, the Cornell University Student Assembly has many resources to promote student
- 19 engagement with such guest speakers. By utilizing them through this series, student education and
- 20 community engagement will be increased.
- Whereas, it is requested that the Committee be allocated \$10,000 from the Student Assembly
- Reserve Account for hosting speakers, advertising events, and granting free admission for the
- 23 Cornell community.
- Whereas, any and all funds unused by the Committee will be transferred and returned to the
- 25 greater Student Assembly upon the dissolution of the Committee.



- 26 **Be it therefore resolved that**, an ad hoc Committee for the organization of a Cornell University
- 27 Student Assembly speaker series for the Spring 2024 semester is created with a funding allocation
- of \$10,000 from the Student Assembly Reserve Account.
