- Reserve Account for hosting speakers, advertising events, and granting free admission for the
- 23 Cornell community.
- Whereas, any and all funds unused by the Committee will be transferred and returned to the
- 25 greater Student Assembly upon the dissolution of the Committee.

- 27 Student Assembly speaker series for the Spring 2024 semester is created with a funding
- allocation of \$10,000 from the Student Assembly Reserve Account.
