Whereas, four colleges within Cornell University are contract colleges. These are the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences, the College of Veterinary Medicine, the College of Human Ecology, and the School of Industrial and Labor Relations;

Whereas, the above colleges are represented by the Student Assembly of the State of New York (SUNY SA);

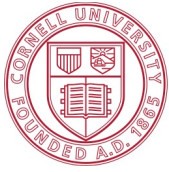
Whereas, the SUNY Student Assembly is a recognized student government organization that represents approximately 400,000 students;

Whereas, the SUNY SA will host an in-person 2022 Spring Conference and General Assembly meeting starting April 29th 2022 and concluding May 1st 2022 at Albany, NY;

Whereas, a community member, who has actively participated in the SUNY SA in the past, has expressed their wishes to attend the conference and for the Student Assembly to cover their conference fee;

Whereas, the conference fee to attend the SUNY SA Conference is \$200

Whereas, the Student Assembly Reserve account currently has a balance of \$91,979.48;
