26 27 28	Be it therefore resolved, the Student Assembly formally requests the final version of the Student Code of Conduct that the Cornell Board of Trustees will vote on;
29 30 31 32 33	Be it further resolved, the Student Assembly requests Cornell administration define explicitly how they intend the Vice President of Student and Campus Life would 'consult' with the Student Assembly and Graduate and Professional Student Assembly, should the Board of Trustees make such a determination;
34 35 36 37 38 39 40	Be it finally resolved, the Board of Trustees vote will be delayed until the first Board of Trustees meeting of the spring semester, when the relevant constituencies, organizations, and bodies impacted have been able to process, comment, and express concerns over the document;
