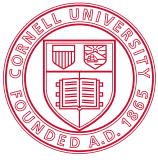


Undergraduate Student Activity Fee Allocation Proposal 2016-2018 Funding Cycle

Alternative Breaks	A student-led program that facilitates service learning spring break trips across the country.	\$1.50
Athletics and Physical Education	Provides a Big Red Sports Pass to each undergraduate and advertises for Cornell Athletics events.	\$10.30
Class Councils	A council that works to foster a sense of unity and pride within the individual class years and among the entire Cornell community.	\$2.20
Club Insurance	Ensures that the events hosted by Cornell students are covered in case of an emergency.	\$5.10
Collegiate Readership Program	Provides students with daily access to newspapers.	\$5.00
