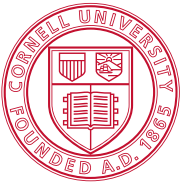

2 Approving Special Prects Request for Big Red Thon

4 ABSTRACT: This resolution approves \$2,040 of Special Projects funding to Big Red Thon for their  
5 annual dance marathon to support Upstate Golisano Children's Hospital in Syracuse.

7 **Sponsored by: Dale Barbaria '19**

9 **Whereas**, according to the Student Assembly Standing Rules, Special Project “Requests \$1500 and  
10 over shall be decided upon by a majority vote of the Appropriations Committee and  
11 confirmed by a majority vote of the Student Assembly, at large. The SA, at large, is only  
12 required to confirm requests of \$1500 or greater. The request should be presented to the  
13 Student Assembly in the form of a resolution;”

15 **Whereas**, the Appropriations Committee, by a majority vote, recommended \$2,040 in Special  
16 Projects Funding to Big Red Thon, Cornell's branch of the nation wide charity initiative,  
17 Dance Marathon, for their November 10<sup>th</sup> dance marathon in Barton Hall to support  
18 Upstate Golisano Children's Hospital in Syracuse;

20 **Whereas**, Big Red Thon has been active and successful every year for the past three years, allowing  
21 undergraduate student organizations and groups to raise money for this local cause;  
22

23 **Whereas**, due to changes in Big Red Thon’s funding model, the organization no longer receives the  
24 same level of funding from the entities that helped found Cornell’s chapter, and Big Red  
25 Thon has not been an active SAFC organization for enough semesters to receive sufficient  
26 SAFC funding to cover the required costs for the event;  
27

28 **Be it therefore resolved**, the Student Assembly approves the \$2,040 Special Projects disbursement  
29 to Big Red Thon for their November 10, 2018 Dance Marathon in Barton Hall;  
30

31 **Be it further resolved**, the Student Assembly necessitates that this funding be used to cover all  
32 costs outlined for the event that are not food items;  
33

34 **Be it finally resolved**, the Student Assembly encourages all undergraduate students to attend Big  
35 Red Thon’s Dance Marathon.
