16 **Whereas**, the Student Assembly finance committee allotted \$750 to the Student Health Advisory
17 Committee for the academic year,

19 **Whereas**, due to COVID-19, the funds were not used and will better serve the student population
20 of Cornell contributing to the Cornell Access Fund.
