## S.A. Resolution #20 Setting the Special Projects Funding Guidelines

ABSTRACT: This resolution proposes rules and guidelines on Special Projects funding.

**Whereas**, currently there are few written guidelines for Special Projects funding

**Whereas**, when the Vice President for Finance, President, Appropriations Committee, and Student Assembly review an application for Special Projects funding, it will follow the guidelines outlined in the Appendix of this resolution,

**Be it therefore, resolved**, that the Student Assembly adopts these changes to the Standing Rules, in Section 8, Subsection B:

Rule 7: Special Projects funding applicants may not:

- i. Apply for Special Projects Funding more than once per semester
- ii. Use Special Projects funding for recurring events except in extremely extenuating circumstances to be determined at the discretion of the Reviewing Body
- iii. Apply for Special Projects funding after the event/initiative date has passed
