







3 4 5 6 7	ABSTRACT: This resolution seeks to allocate a portion of the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund on the projects selected by the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee of 2015-2016 as outlined below.
8 9	Sponsored by: Miranda Kasher '19
10 11 12	<b>Whereas</b> , the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee currently operates a budget of \$100,909.73;
13 14 15	<b>Whereas</b> , the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee received 58 proposals for funding in the Fall of 2015;
16 17 18	<b>Whereas</b> , the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee completed 2 of the 58 proposed projects without funding;
19 20 21	<b>Be it therefore resolved</b> , that the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee allocate \$30,000 to add four Gothic Standard lights on the slope;
22 23 24	<b>Be it therefore resolved</b> , that the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee allocate \$20,000 to the renovation of the plaza in front of the Schwartz Center;
25 26 27	<b>Be it therefore resolved</b> , that the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee allocate \$15,000 to the renovation of and the addition of outlets to the Green Dragon Café in Sibley Hall;
28 29 30	<b>Be it therefore resolved</b> , that the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee allocate \$5,000 to the addition of hand dryers in a highly trafficked public restroom;
31 32 33	<b>Be it therefore resolved</b> , that the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee allocate \$1,000 to adding condom dispensers in two or three highly trafficked areas of campus;
34 35 36	<b>Be it therefore resolved,</b> that the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee allocate \$500 to the addition of coat hangers in bathrooms across campus;
37 38 39	<b>Be it therefore resolved</b> , that the Student Assembly Infrastructure Fund Committee allocate \$250 to the waste bin and signage project let by the Student Assembly Environmental Committee;
40 41 42	<b>Be it therefore resolved</b> , that if a project costs more than estimated, the committee will review the project and consider allocating additional funding;
43 44 45 46	<b>Be it finally resolved</b> , that any funds not allocated or not used in the projects above will be kept in reserve as rollover to be used during the 2016-2017 school year and will not be returned to the principal amount;
