

1. Log in to the Office of the Assemblies Petition Signature website:

2. Click on “+New Petition”



- **Division of Financial Affairs, Budget & Planning, Audit & Investment Representative (1 year term)**
- **Health & Safety Representative (3 year term)**

- **Division of Human Resources Representative (3 year term)**
- **School of Industrial & Labor Relations Representative (2 year term)**
- **International Representative At-Large (3 year term)**
- **Library and Museum Representative (3 year term)**
- **More than 20 Years of Service Representative At-Large (3 year term)**
- **School of Public Policy Representative (3 year term)**
- **Representative At-Large (2 seats available – 2 year term)**




2. View Petitions (search by keyword to find your candidate)
