| 18 | encountered issues and difficulties regarding receiving adequate information or ensuring the |

| 21 22 | Whereas , these issues and difficulties have created a situation where appointments to the Boards may be delayed, impairing the sound functioning of Cornell's Campus Judicial System; and |
