In the event of a vacancy in the Judicial Administrator's office, the procedure laid out in Article II, Section A, Subsection 3 of Campus Code of Conduct for constituting a search will be followed. Incumbent occupants of each office may serve any number of consecutive terms; however, no single term may exceed two years in duration.
