6	Whereas, the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has greatly limited campus-wide operations and
7 8	modified the timeline of priorities for the University Assembly and other assemblies for the remaining 2019-2020 academic calendar, and
9	Temaning 2019-2020 academic calendar, and
0	Whereas, Section 5.2 of the Charter of the Cornell University Assembly states that the term of
1	each Officer is concurrent with a session of the Assembly, and

13	Whereas, the inability of in-person voting for the remainder of the 2019-2020 academic calenda
4	prevents a secret ballot in closed session from being held in the current session of the Assembly
5	as required by Section 5.3 of the Charter of the Cornell University Assembly, and

7	Whereas, the current status of the COVID-19 pandemic remains unclear in regards to the
8	possibility of in-person voting of a secret ballot beyond the 2019-2020 academic calendar into
9	the Summer session, and

21	Whereas, other Assemblies of the University have already postponed their election process until
22 23	the Fall 2020 semester,
23	
24	Be it therefore resolved, the election of the University Assembly Officers be conducted in the
25	first regularly scheduled meeting in the next session of the Assembly for the 2020-2021
26	Academic Calendar, and
27	
28	Be it further resolved, the current term of the 2019-2020 University Assembly Officers be
29	extended until the first regularly scheduled meeting in the next session of the Assembly for the
30	2020-2021 Academic Calendar.
