16 **Whereas,** Chief Zoner will leave Cornell on March 4, 2019 to become director of organizational
17 assessments at Margolis Healy; and

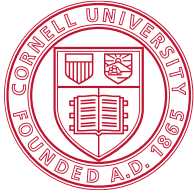
