


## U.A. Resolution # 3 Calling for the Development of a Strategic Plan September 26, 2017

6	Whereas, senior leadership recognizes the critical need to address issues of injustice, racism and
7	bigotry, in the wake of separate incidents on or near campus this semester, and to develop and/or enhance
8	programs and services that support diversity and inclusion on our campuses; and

10	Whereas, many in our campus community are dealing with questions and concerns about recent U.S.
11	executive actions on immigration travel bans, and DACA and undocumented students—and the current and
12	future implications for student, faculty, and staff activities and our international programs; and

14	Whereas, the Senior Leaders Climate Action Group is working to integrate sustainability and climate action
15	strategies into the campus culture and strategic planning process; and

17 18	Whereas, the opening of the tech campus in New York City marks the beginning of a new era of
19	unprecedented opportunity for Cornell, which hinges upon our ability to take advantage of cross-college synergies and develop institutional capacity to act as "One Cornell" and create more connections among the
20	distinct parts; and

22	Whereas, there is an ongoing tension between our ambitious aspirations to enhance diversity, sustainability,
23	connectivity between colleges and campuses, and global impact, and the limited availability of new resources
24	to fund these aspirations; and

26	Whereas, the most recent strategic plan was completed in May 2010 and set forth specific objectives and
27	actions for the university for the period of 2010-2015; and

29	Whereas, this plan has not been updated to reflect the changing environment for higher education in
30	general and for Cornell in particular; and

32	Whereas, the strategic plan will guide institutional decisions about where to invest resources (i.e.,
33	time, effort, and money); therefore



34	Be it therefore resolved, that the University Assembly formally requests that the president and
35	provost of Cornell University initiate a strategic planning process to begin in fall 2018 and be
36	completed by spring of 2019; and

38	Be it Further Resolved, that the university administration should partner with all assemblies and ensure
39	that faculty, students, and staff share in the strategic planning process and have a meaningful role in shaping
10	the final strategic plan; and

12	Be it Further Resolved, that all assemblies will have the ability to appoint members to the strategic
13	planning advisory council in the process of crafting the new strategic plan; and
14	
15	Be it Finally Resolved, that the university administration should formally present a status update on the
16	strategic plan to the University Assembly by October 2019.
