In Support of Making Cornell a Sanctuary Campus

Whereas , Cornell students, faculty, staff, and alumni have circulated a petition to make Cornell a sanctuary campus; ¹
Whereas, more than 2,000 Cornell students, faculty, staff, and alumni have already signed and shown their support for the Cornell petition;
Whereas, such petitions are also circulating at over 100 other colleges and universities across the country; ²
Whereas, more than 90 college and university presidents and chancellors from across the U.S. have already signed a statement calling for the continuation and expansion of the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program; ^{3,4}
Whereas , following the United States presidential election on November 8, 2016, there has been an increase in the frequency of recorded events of discriminatory and hateful action against people of color, queer people, immigrants, Muslims, and other historically marginalized people on and off college campuses across the U.S.; ^{5,6,7}
